



Gift-In-Kind Donation Guidelines

Definition of a Gift-In-Kind (In-Kind) Donation

A gift-in-kind means a gift of anything other than cash. It means the gift of goods, services, and property, other than cash. Such gifts are often made for charitable purposes.

Accepted items- all items must be new except when noted

- **Art supplies:** yarn, knitting and crochet supplies, acrylic paint, decorative papers, drawing materials (colored pencils, and crayons)
- **Comfort items** (i.e. blankets, slippers, small pillows, eye masks, water bottles, cards of encouragement, etc.)
- **Entertainment** (i.e. Sudoku or crossword puzzles, books, magazines, playing cards, etc.)
- **Handmade items** (i.e. port pillows, blankets, hats, etc.)
 - Made/stored in pet, smoke, and odor free environment
 - New fabric and materials
 - Laundered, dried and put into individual or large plastic bags prior to donating
- **Hats**
 - Chemo (soft materials)
 - Summer (brimmed or light weight)
 - Winter (thick)
- **Books and magazines** (new or lightly used)
- **Performance** (i.e. comedic, musical, dance, etc.)
- **Personal care items** (i.e. lotion, lip balm, etc.)
 - Unscented, store bought, packaged individually
- **Snacks** (nonperishable food)
 - Store bought, packaged individually

Items we do not accept

- New or used wigs
- Used hats/clothing
- Political or religious materials
- Solicitation materials
